ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

MIXED PAPER TOTER

White paper
Colored paper
Computer paper
Construction paper
Envelopes
Envelopes with windows
Cereal boxes (remove liners)
Cracker boxes (remove liners)
Gift boxes
Paper towel rolls
Magazines
Newspapers & inserts
Catalogues
Phone books
Junk mail
*Cardboard (cut to fit inside toter)
Adhesive notes
Paper egg cartons
Brown paper grocery bags
Wrapping paper

CANS AND BOTTLES TOTER

Tin & Aluminum cans
Glass bottles & jars
Plastic containers labeled #1 - #7
Aseptics: milk cartons & juice boxes
Aluminum foil & pie pans (*clean*)
Metal lids from glass bottles & jars
Metal pots & pans

NEWSPAPER TOTER

All newspapers
Newspaper inserts

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

All unmarked Plastics (plastics without a 1 through 7 Recycling Symbol)
Food contaminated paper products or packaging
Pizza boxes
Waxed cardboard
Styrofoam packing “peanuts”
Plastic bubblewrap
Light bulbs
Clothes hangers
Ceramics
Garden hoses
Window glass
Wire rope
Fuel tanks
Auto parts
Plastic utensils
Plastic toys
PVC or other plastic piping
Syringes and other Medical or Hazardous Waste

PLEASE NOTE:

*Large amounts of Cardboard should be flattened, bundled and tied. Bundles must be no larger than 3 feet x 3 feet, and placed alongside recycling cart.
